Here in the death of Christ I live.

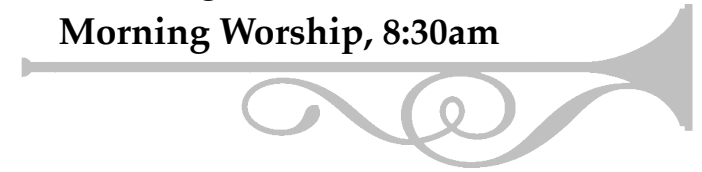
There in the ground His body lay,
